

Hourly rate for courtroom graphics, video, and animation

Principal's time	\$125 ph
Associates' time, graphics	\$95 ph (except videography)
Videography	varies, generally around \$125 - \$175 ph

Hours are drawn from retainer, with unused hours promptly returned at end of the project. The first \$1000 of each retainer is non-refundable if a project is canceled.

Per diem

full day, courtroom presentation: \$1500

this includes:

- Principal's time (eight hours including set up, liaison with court, preparing files) and two hours' travel time
- Duplicated 1024x768 projectors at \$100 each per day
- Custom calibration and focusing software provided
- Tripod mount and adjustable support for projector
- Duplicated laptops at \$100 each per day
- Presentation software on both laptops included
- DVD player if required
- Sound system suitable for a small courtroom (larger courtrooms may require additional amplification and speakers)
- Relevant files on each laptop included
- Review monitor for live projector
- Tripod free standing projection screen if required
- Remote clicker to advance slideshows if required
- All cabling, extensions, and connections
- Insurance for equipment

does not include: meals, accommodation, travel over two hours, mileage

Please note that Studio Cruz does not recommend the use of DVD players for animated or video demonstratives due to inherent problems with the DVD compression format, which can cause playback problems if subjected to frequent pausing or backing up. However, for video depositions where the DVD is to be played linearly from start to finish, the format is reliable.
